We at Law Enforcement Training look forward to you attending the Basic Law Enforcement Training Session, August 18 – November 15, 2013. Check-in and orientation will begin promptly at 5:00 PM CDT, Sunday, August 18, 2013 at the George S. Mickelson Criminal Justice Center, north of Pierre on Highway 14. If you are unable to be here at that time, please notify us immediately.

Please review the enclosed Student Handbook regarding the rules and regulations for the Training Center and the items needed for your stay during the training session. In the back of the handbook are the waivers and the Fitness Assessment data sheet that each student will participate in. You should be prepared to perform any activity on the assessment.

- 1. <u>All completed waivers and forms</u> for the Law Enforcement Basic Training Session are to be completed and turned in during orientation on <u>August 18<sup>th</sup></u>.
- 2. CPR Certification and ICS 100, 200 and 700 are mandatory for the Law Enforcement Basic Training Course. Please bring a copy of your current CPR certification (adult, infant, & child), and a copy of your ICS 100, 200, and 700 certificates to turn in during orientation, August 8th. There will be an opportunity to complete these courses on your own time while attending the academy.
- 3. You are encouraged to bring your own bedding. We have regular twin size beds.
- 4. <u>Leather gear, mouthpiece, & groin protection</u> needed for PPCT training.
- 5. <u>CLEAR, full wrap around side, impact resistant, and scratch resistant coating protective eye wear, duty weapon (including three magazines), holster and leather/belt gear and a baseball cap (not red), will be needed for firearms training, beginning the first week of training.</u>

Dorm rooms are pre-assigned by Law Enforcement Training. Breakfast, lunch, and evening meals are served Monday through Thursday. Breakfast is served on Fridays, and generally the lunch meal, depending on the schedule. There are no meals provided on weekends.

While at the Center, classes are generally scheduled from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday, with some evening classes. Thank you for your interest and we look forward to seeing you on the 3<sup>rd</sup>.
