**ORDER OF
ADDITIONAL BOND CONDITIONS
(24/7 SOBRIETY PROGRAM)**

THIS COURT HEREBY ORDERS THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF BOND:
(Initial appropriate blanks, where applicable)

Defendant shall participate in the 24/7 Sobriety Program, and shall execute and comply with all terms and conditions of the Participation Agreement required by that Program. Further, as part of the Program, Defendant shall not use or possess any controlled drugs or substances, or marijuana, nor consume, use or possess alcohol in any form. Defendant shall immediately enroll in the 24/7 Sobriety Program at:

Defendant shall submit to testing in the form of:

_____ Twice daily PBT tests, and pay all testing and participation fees at the rates and amounts set by administrative rule.

_____ Continuous alcohol monitor testing (CAM) or Remote Breath (if available), and pay all testing, participation, installation and deactivation fees at the rates and amounts set by administrative rule. Unless otherwise directed, advanced payment for testing and participation fees will be made to the testing agency.

_____ Urinalysis testing when directed by the testing entity's representative and pay all testing fees at the rate set by administrative rule, and for each test and actual costs incurred for the analysis of any positive test.

_____ Drug patch testing as directed by the testing entity's representative and pay all testing fees at the rate set by administrative rule.

_____ Defendant shall submit to a search of Defendant's vehicle, residence and/or person for alcohol, controlled drugs or substances or marijuana, whenever requested by a law enforcement officer.

_____ Other: _____

This Order shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered. Should you fail to report for your court ordered testing requirements, or violate any condition herein, a violation will be created and forwarded to the State's Attorney's Office. You will remain on the program and be expected to continue to test as ordered.

If a Defendant is unable to pay for testing, a report shall be sent to the State's Attorney's Office, or to the court (with copies to the State's Attorney and any defense counsel), as required in your jurisdiction. If the court has issued a warrant for 24/7 violation(s), the agency shall execute that warrant.

Should you test positive on any test, you may be arrested, transported to the County Jail, and held without bond until the matter is brought before the Court. If law enforcement is unable to locate you, a warrant may be issued for your arrest.
